Forms of participation:

You can contribute theoretical, empirical, methodological, or practical examples in the following formats:

- **Oral Presentations:** Participants can present their work orally. Presentations will be organized by the organizing committee in different sessions according to thematic areas.
- **Poster Presentations:** In poster presentations, early-stage projects (e.g. PhD projects) or selected results can be presented in a poster (A0).

Panels and training programs will also be held within the scope of the Forum.

About ANISF

Antalya International Science Forum (ANISF) was organized for the first time in November 2023 under the leadership of Akdeniz University Social Policy and Migration Studies Application and Research Centre (ASPAG) and the co-leadership of Antalya Metropolitan Municipality, Friedrich Ebert Foundation Türkiye Representative Office, Hydropolitics Association (HPA) and Centre for Studies on Turkey and Integration Research (ZfTI); also, in cooperation with various institutions and organizations from Türkiye and abroad.

The aim of this international platform is to develop interdisciplinary approaches and action plans to solve global and local problems.

In the first event in 2023, nearly 60 papers were presented by scientists, NGO representatives, practitioners from private and public institutions from Türkiye and different countries, and about 700 participants took part in the Program, where training programs, conferences and panels were held.
